

## Aussie Quick Quilt table topper (22" x 38") ©AussieQuickQuilt

Things you need:

Quilt kit

Rotary cutter and mat

101 quilt basting spray

4 pins for binding corners

### Preparation:


1: Taking the panel, separate the borders and the end triangles by cutting along the middle of the white lines. Then separate the two triangle strips. Please do use a rotary cutter and long ruler for this as scissors will not give you an even line.



2: With the first strip of triangles, fold between them and stitch using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam making sure you stitch past the white. Repeat for all the triangles then do the same on the second strip.




3: Now attach the top strip, leaving an overhang at each end for trimming level after.




Once sewn, press seam towards border and trim each end level.

Next add the border triangles on, making sure the point where the arrow indicates lines up first Then stitch from the top down.



Now join the two halves matching seams as needed.



Press your top out and then Refer to the videos below on how to baste, quilt and back bind your table topper.
